REQUESTS TO CONDUCT NON-BOARD INITIATED RESEARCH

4123

1. Rationale

The Simcoe County District School Board (SCDSB) supports evidence-informed and research-based practice. The objective of this policy is to establish authority for reviewing requests from universities, colleges, other agencies, and individuals to conduct non-board initiated research within the school board.

2. Policy

- 2.1 It is the policy of the SCDSB to follow established procedures for approving or rejecting any non-board initiated (external) research applications which involve students, parents/guardians or staff of the SCDSB.
- 2.2 The SCDSB's Research and Decision Support Services department and the External Research Review Committee (ERRC) shall ensure that:
 - 2.2.1 external research applications approved by the ERRC contribute to the SCDSB's Strategic Priorities;
 - 2.2.2 schools and classrooms have minimal disruption from participation in an approved research project; and,
 - 2.2.3 all ethical principles for conducting research are upheld in accordance with the ERRC's approval to conduct research within the SCDSB.

3. Administrative Procedures

The Director of Education is authorized to provide the administrative procedures necessary to implement this policy.
