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Subject	GRADE 8 STUDENTS – SECONDARY SCHOOL INFORMATION PROCEDURES

The Simcoe County District School Board (SCDSB) encourages its elementary students to continue their secondary education in SCDSB secondary schools. To assist Grade 8 students and their parents/guardians in choosing secondary school programs best suited for students' needs, the following procedures are to be followed:

- 1. Secondary school programming and graduation requirements are to be provided by SCDSB secondary school staff to Grade 8 students currently registered in SCDSB schools. Elementary school principals shall ensure that all Grade 8 students receive this information.
- 2. SCDSB information regarding secondary programs and/or information sessions for Grade 8 students shall be provided to all Grade 8 students.
- 3. School visits held during the day for Grade 8 students shall only be to SCDSB secondary schools.
- 4. SCDSB elementary schools shall only host Grade 8 student information sessions offered by SCDSB staff.
- 5. Elementary and secondary principals shall review these procedures annually with their staff.
- 6. Elementary school principals shall provide information regarding transitional plans and dates for Grade 8 students and their parents/guardians through the September school newsletter and school website. Providing this information at the beginning of each school year will allow students and their parents/guardians to prepare for a successful transition to secondary school.

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
